## **ONE TIP**

### **Extract single pages from a text pdf**

Make sure the sidebar is showing; it displays thumbnails of the document pages. If not, press command/shift/D.

In the sidebar, select the page you want (click on it) and drag it to the desktop. Preview will now create a new file, giving it the same name but with the suffix *dragged*. If you select multiple (even non-contiguous) pages and drag them to the desktop, you will create a single file with all of them.
