Getting to the Arnold Firehouse EPFD Station 1 on Blagen Road in Arnold:

The street address is 1037 Blagen Road in Arnold. It is between the Post Office and the Library on Blagen. To reach it you come up (or down) Hwy #4 into Arnold. When you reach the Chevron Station on the left hand side (coming up), you make a gentle left turn onto Blagen Road, which will take you past Ace Hardware and the Post Office. Mavericks (OSX 10.9) is available from the Apple Store for FREE.

I hooked up my MacBook Pro to the internet by Ethernet (not wireless).

Started at 9:40 AM, download started.

Needed to start additional installation process at 10:10AM (Because of this step you must be at your computer while downloading).

Finished at 11:15 AM

Your computer will re-start after completion of the install.

After re-start, another 10 minutes to go.

Completed at 11:30 AM.

Programs that are not comparable are listed, you can contact the company for an update if necessary.
