MANAGING PHOTOS JUNE 9 SMUG TOPIC

Taking full advantage of Apple's new Photos application will be the main topic when the Sierra Macintosh Users Group (SMUG) has its monthly meeting Tuesday, June 9, beginning at 7 p.m. in the assembly room of the Ebbetts Pass Fire District, 1037 Blagen Rd., just off Highway 4.

SMUG president Dick Cross, who has amassed tens of thousands of pictures in his personal collection, will make the presentation and attempt to answer all the pertinent questions from those in attendance.

"Photos for Mac is the long anticipated replacement for iPhoto and Aperture," says Cross. "It mirrors the iPhone and iPad apps that have been available for some time, but with expanded capabilities. I will discuss the capabilities of the new application as well as the migration strategies from iPhoto and Aperture."

Everyone is encouraged to bring his or her other Mac related questions to be addressed.

SMUG meets the second Tuesday of each month. Meetings are open to everyone and there is no charge to attend. The organization exists to keep Mac users abreast of the latest developments and to address the nagging questions that arise from time to time.
